



- Has brought significant wealth globally.


GDP per capita PPP current international \$ 1990-2022 world countries by income





- Need to manage tensions and prevent conflicts.




The Seneca Effect

- Bardi explores the asymmetrical path of growth and decline in complex systems.
- Stresses the roles of **tipping points** and **attractors**.
- Various types of collapse are considered.
- Societal response to uncertain periods may not be sufficient.



China's plagued with profund issues regarding consumption and production.


- Its governance struggles with challenges such as corruption.

- China's problem are also **our own**.





Total greenhouse gas emissions (kt of CO2 equivalent - China), via World Bank data




Renewable energy consumption (% of total energy consumption) - China, via World Bank Data


